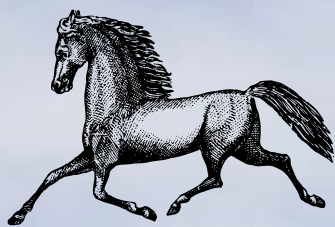

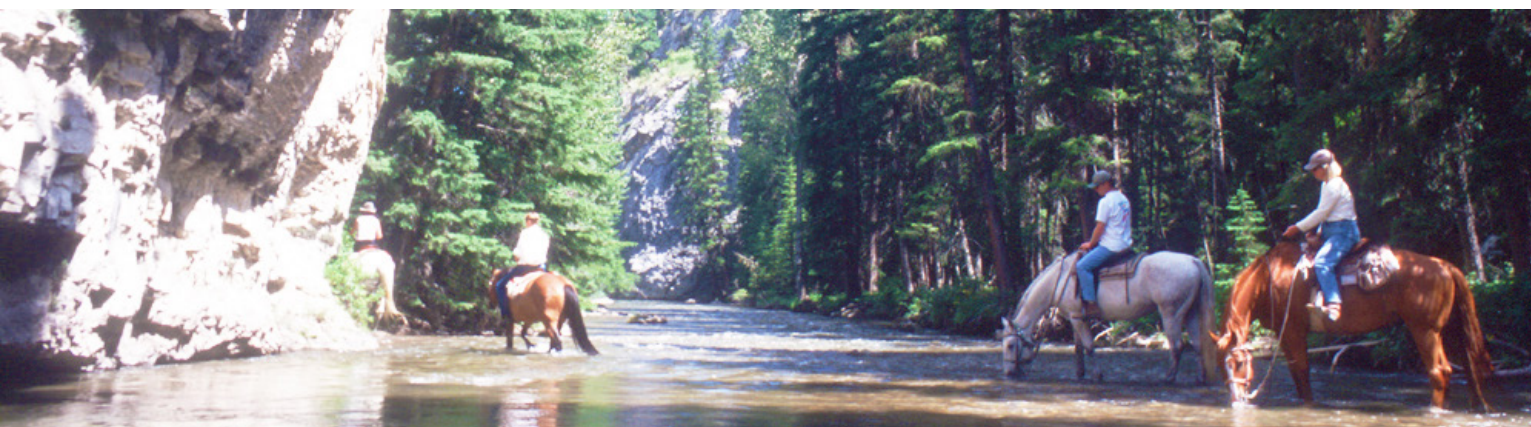

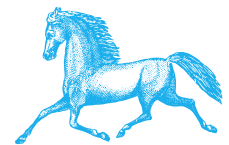
Horseback RIDING

Riding is what they are known for here!

Daily rides will take you through river crossings, across open meadows and through dense pine forests; with rides where trotting and loping can be incorporated - all offered several times throughout the week. So if you're traveling with friends that don't ride as much, or want to ride at a more relaxing pace - Circle Bar Guest Ranch has you covered!

Riding is offered most mornings and afternoons, with specialty rides like a breakfast ride and cattle drive ride offered weekly.

When not riding, or if traveling with a non rider, there is ample trout fishing, archery, shooting, hiking or simply relaxing in the hot tub.

Terrain:

With our neighboring 2.8 million acres of the Helena Lewis and Clark National Forest, there are endless trails to explore. Terrain will be varied from open prairie to narrow, mountainous forest trails. There are river crossings on most rides.

We offer two rides per day, except Sundays when the horses have the afternoon off. New guests will take a slow walking ride first, and then can move onto more advanced rides with trotting and loping if you demonstrate you can safely control your horse.
